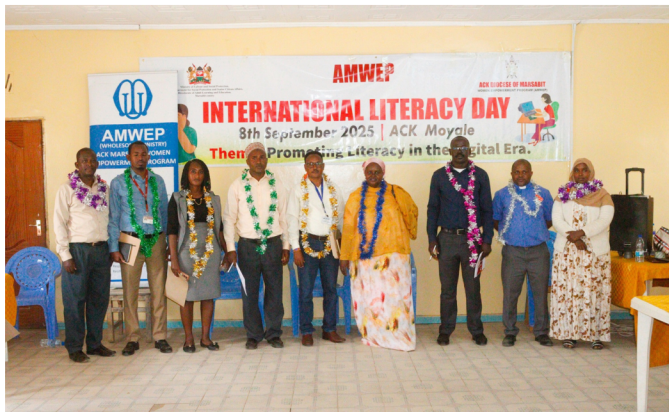
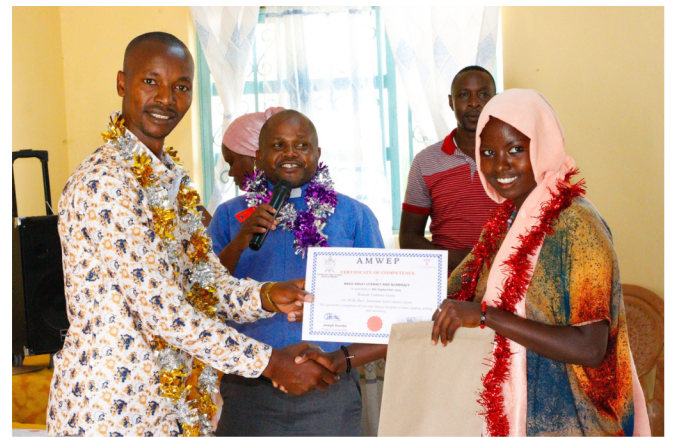


Celebrating International Literacy Day at ACK St. Paul's Church, Moyale ✨🇰🇪 Sept 8 2025

The Diocese of Marsabit successfully held a training summit for youth and children workers, graced by Bishop Qampicha, Canon Mark Kargi, Provost Kennedy Akhongo, and Archdeacon Ven. Joseph Kesho. Over 100 participants engaged in intensive Scripture exposition, interactive Bible studies, and practical presentations designed to equip them for ministry.

Sessions addressed critical issues including drug abuse, career guidance, relationships, sexual purity, social media awareness, and mental health.
